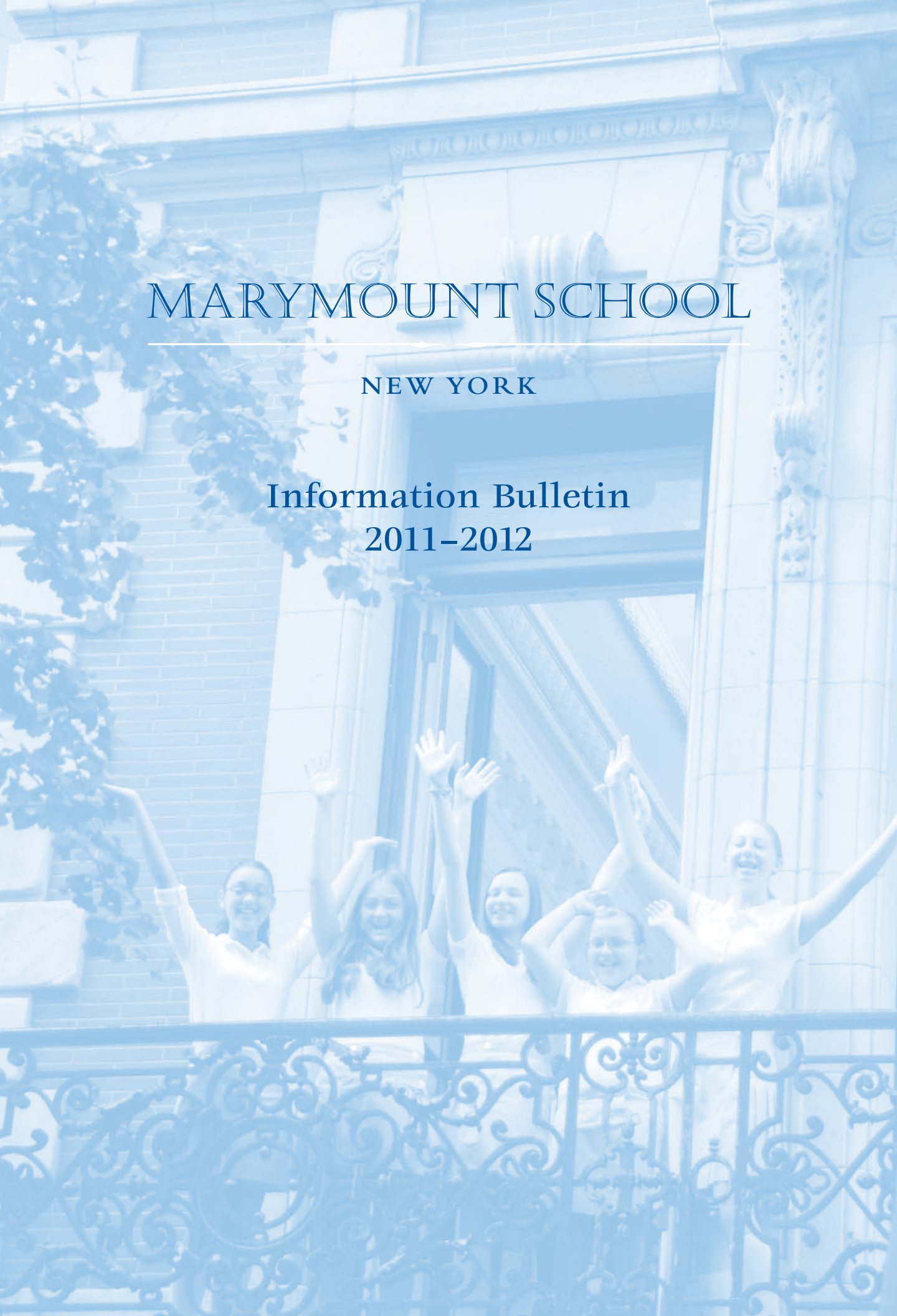

The charges set forth above include lunch, books, supplies, activities, yearbook, and the Parents Association fees. A non-refundable deposit of \$5,000 is required of all students when accepted by the school. This deposit is credited toward the November 1st payment.

Two-thirds of the annual tuition is due on May 2nd and one-third (less the deposit) on November 1st. No reduction and no refunds are made for absence or withdrawal before the end of the year.
